The first run of the game came in the top of the third inning, when Chris Jackson's one-out single up the middle scored Steven Bumbry, who had tripled in the preceding at-bat. The Express' lone run came in the bottom of the third inning, when Bart Pettus tied the game by scoring on a Swinson wild pitch. The Orioles scored the game's final run in the top of the fifth inning, when Chris Henderson's two-out single scored Justin Bour.

The Express managed only three hits over the last six innings, with its only serious threat coming on a Mike DeLeeuw two-out double in the bottom of the seventh inning. Swinton retired the final seven batters he faced and dealt the Express their fourth consecutive loss.
