Former Astoria player Supple throws a no hitter

A player who spent his younger days playing ball on the North Coast is having plenty of success on the East Coast this summer.

Having just completed his sophomore year at Santa Clara University in California, Joe Supple is pitching for the Rockville (Maryland) Express in the Cal Ripken, Sr. Collegiate Baseball League.

Last week, Supple tossed a no-hitter against the Maryland Redbirds, only the second nine-inning no-hitter in the league's history.

He allowed one run with eight strikeouts and five walks in the 2-1 win, and lowered his team-leading ERA to 2.84. For his performance, Supple was named the Cal Ripken, Sr. Collegiate Baseball League Pitcher of the Week for July 6-12.

The 6-foot-3, 190-pound Supple is 2-2 on the year, with two complete-game victories.
